To reinforce continuous improvement, Hotel Marina Elite has approved an **Annual Sustainability Action Plan** covering the period **November 2025 – November 2026**.

Key planned objectives include:

- **Waste and recycling:**
Reduce non-recyclable waste by 10% and increase recycling rates above 70%.
- **Single-use plastics:**
Eliminate single-use plastics in operational departments and guest areas.
- **Energy efficiency:**
Reduce electricity consumption by 5%, including the installation of solar lighting in common areas.
- **Water efficiency:**
Reduce water consumption per guest by 5% through monitoring and preventive maintenance.
- **Biodiversity and environment:**
Promote respect for local flora and fauna through educational signage and QR-based information.
- **Local community:**
Increase collaboration with local suppliers, artisans and sustainable initiatives.
- **Staff wellbeing:**
Promote a fair, inclusive and healthy working environment.
- **Communication and transparency:**
Publish sustainability reports and improve internal and external sustainability communication.

- Increased awareness among guests and staff.
- Improved resource management practices.
- Stronger protection of marine and local biodiversity.

6. Review and Continuous Improvement


This public sustainability progress report will be **reviewed annually by hotel management**, ensuring alignment with Travelife requirements and continuous improvement objectives.
